Precautions and maintenance

- Moisten the cleaning cloth with the cleaning solution; do not apply cleaning agent directly on the screen.


Warning



Installing & Replacing The Battery



Hold the remote control upside down, press the ridged area of the battery cover and pull towards you to remove the tray. Place one cr2025 lithium button-cell battery in the tray with the positive "+" side facing you. Reinsert the tray.

Getting Started

1. Place the digital photo frame with installed stand on a flat surface. Connect the power adapter to a standard electrical outlet and DC in on the left side of the unit.

 Remove the plastic battery insulator from the battery compartment and make sure the remote control has a battery inserted. Refer to "installing & replacing the battery" if a new battery is needed.

3. The unit will start up automatically when powered on. Press power at the rear of the unit or on the remote control to switch the unit on or off.

Main Screen(Memory Card and USB Device)

SD/MMC cards and USB 2.0 devices are supported.

After inserting a memory card or USB device, press [RETURN] until main screen as below appears. Press \blacktriangleleft or \triangleright to select memory device.



If supported photo, music and video files are stored in the memory card or USB drive, the slide show will start automatically with background music, or you can switch this function off in Setting menu.

Note: when multiple memory cards are inserted at same time, the files in USB drive will be played first.

- Press [RETURN] to enter the 12-picture thumbnail mode and select the photo for full screen display with ▼▲◀▶.

Music Mode

Select [Music] and press [OK] or press [MUSIC] on remote control to enter.





Slideshow (Picture + Music)



Select [Slideshow] and press [OK] or press [BGM] on remote control to enter.

Press 🔘 to pause music slideshow and only show pictures. Press 🔘 again, then the music slideshow play.

Note: if press [RETURN], slideshow is finished and turn to picture thumbnail mode.

Video Mode

Connecting to PC

You can connect the digital photo frame via USB cable to a PC to copy, delete or edit files.

- Switch the Digital Photo Frame on, then connect it to your PC. Windows 2000, XP, Vista, 7, 10 and MAC OS are supported.
- The digital photo frame will be automatically detected and the "Connection" icon is displayed. You can now copy, delete and edit files. You need to restart the Digital Photo Frame after finishing the copy, delete or edit operation.
